

## From the Executive Director

Dear NOYO Community,

It's my pleasure to share with you this report on NOYO's 52nd concert season. I'm proud to affirm that our tradition of high-quality, accessible music education continues even in the face of the strong headwinds and unprecedented instability that have frustrated so much musical activity all over the world in the past year.

Our 2020-21 concert season was unlike any in NOYO's half-century history: rather than meet in person, we held weekly online rehearsals via Zoom. Instead of live concerts, we assembled composite performance videos featuring our musicians and conductors. (Check them out on our YouTube channel!)

Our exceptional artistic staff developed and refined new pedagogies for ensemble-based music education in a virtual format. We found ways to offer excellent teaching to any young musician in northeast Ohio with an internet connection and a computer or mobile device, and we reduced tuition and allocated financial aid to make our programs affordable for everyone. We recognize that the availability of first-rate music education is still not as equitable as it must become, but our commitment to closing that gap remains central to NOYO's identity.

Among the many lessons this challenging year taught us, we learned that even an excellent online orchestra program can't quite deliver the same immediacy, vividness, and camaraderie that in-person NOYO rehearsals provide. As we prepare to resume live activities in the Fall, we'll never again take for granted the value of making music together.

Something I've been waiting a long time to say: I look forward to seeing you soon.


